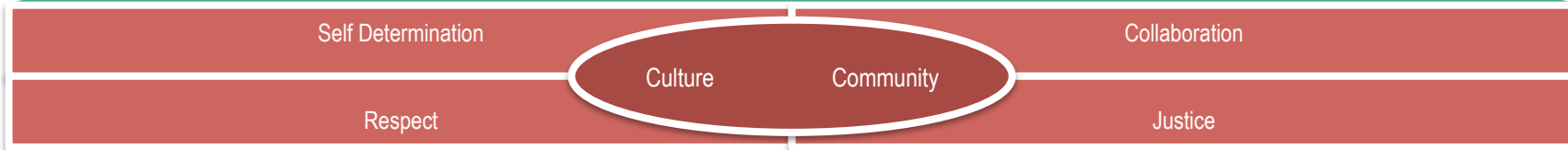


Aboriginal children & young people have the same opportunities and resources as other young Australians
